### Selection ranks

#### Lowest selection rank in 2018

The lowest selection rank in 2018 is the **minimum** 2017 year 12 selection rank (equivalent to an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) after any equity or subject adjustments have been applied) which secured an offer into a course/program **in 2018** for applicants competing with year 12 results.

#### What is guaranteed entry?

Guaranteed entry is the **minimum** year 12 selection rank (equivalent to an ATAR after any equity or subject adjustments have been applied) which will guarantee selection into a course/program **in 2019** for applicants competing with year 12 results.

For many courses/programs, the final selection rank used will drop below the guaranteed entry threshold.

### What is a selection rank?

The selection rank is the rank used to determine your competitiveness relative to other applicants. If you are competing with your year 12 results your selection rank for most courses will be based on your ATAR, adjusted to take account of any equity or subject adjustments to which you are entitled.

#### Adjustment factors and selection ranks

Equity and subject adjustments are not added directly to an ATAR when calculating a selection rank. Your ATAR is derived from your university aggregate. If you are eligible for equity or subject adjustments they will be added to your university aggregate and a selection rank (equivalent to an ATAR after any equity or subject adjustments have been applied) calculated.

For the small number of courses where additional entry requirements are used, the selection rank will be calculated according to rules provided by the university offering the course.
