

University of South Australia Study Grant

Duration	Maximum duration 4 years full-time or part-time equivalent, excluding any periods of leave.
Value	\$2,000 per year based on a full-time load.
Payment	Recipients will receive two (2) instalments by May and October for the duration of their studies, up to a maximum of four (4) years .

Citizenship/Residency	Open to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Australian citizens • Australian permanent residents • Holders of a permanent humanitarian visa
Level of study	Open to all undergraduate students enrolled in a Commonwealth supported place.
Attendance	Full-time or part-time student.
Type of course/program	You must be enrolled in a Commonwealth supported place.
Financial hardship	You must demonstrate financial hardship.
Other disadvantages	While low socio-economic status is the primary criterion for UniSA Study Grants, applications will be weighted according to other equity indicators, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Regional/Remote disadvantage • Non-English Speaking Background (NESB) • Disability • Indigenous Australian
Previous qualification	You must not have already completed the requirements of a program of study equivalent to an Australian Bachelor's or higher level award.
Receiving other scholarships	You are not eligible if you are eligible for a Commonwealth Scholarship, Start-up or Relocation Scholarships, Income Contingent Loan from Centrelink or in receipt of any other UniSA-related scholarship or grant of the same or higher value to the UniSA Study or Priority Grants.
