## YEAR 10

Designed to complement the Personal Learning Plan (PLP), the Year 10 Presentation looks at personal attributes that may impact on students' career decision making. It introduces students to university study and factors that should be taken into consideration when looking at tertiary study as an option.

We explore a typical week in the life of a university student highlighting the key differences between school and university as well as discussing:

- > Self-discovery and strengths
- > What to look for when choosing a career
- > Prerequisites/assumed knowledge and subject selection
- > Overview of pathways and university entry requirements

Presented at your school or at one of our university campuses the presentation fits into a single lesson time taking 30–45 minutes.

MyCareerMatch is an online career profiling tool available to schools to assist in delivering personalised career reports to students outlining information about their personality style and a list of career options complimentary to their natural strengths and talents. When combined with a Year 10 Presentation, MyCareerMatch is available for schools to use free-of-charge through sponsorship from UniSA.



## YEAR 11

This interactive presentation is designed to test student knowledge about university study including what life as a university student is like and the differences between school and tertiary study.

We discuss things to consider when researching and choosing a university degree as well as:

- > Tips on what to look for when planning your career
- > Understanding university – what university is really like
- > Overview of the SATAC application process
- > Transitioning to Year 12 and how to prepare for life beyond school

<b>Health Sciences</b>			
Chemistry: Where can chemistry take you?	City East	60	Revealing chemistry's use in a variety of different fields, this workshop showcases how chemistry is applied every day in the health industry. Students learn in our purpose-built laboratories about chemical reactions, the process of chromatography, and the environmental impact of human activity.
Biology: Applied science in real life	City East	60	Designed to take students beyond the idea of "scientists in a laboratory" and demonstrate the application in real life situations, students will learn about the science of life through human anatomy and living organisms in the study of physiology. Students will expand their knowledge of the impact of biology, particularly in the diagnosis and treatment of patients.
Physics: The science of force and motion	City East	60	Explore the area of physics, the natural science. Learning the science of force and motion, students can also gain an understanding of the behaviour of energy and related concepts that can be applied throughout various health careers.
Nutrition: The importance of food	City East	60	Broaden your students understanding and awareness of the importance of food and nutrition. Students can learn the importance of promoting and managing foods for optimum health, as well as exploring the reasons for food choice by consumers, impact of dietary decisions within the population and the meaning behind a functional food.
Health and Physical Education: The impact of exercise and physical activity on human life	City East	60	Designed for students with an interest in sport, exercise and science, and physical education, this workshop explores the impact of exercise and physical activity on human life. Students become involved in scientific practical training and testing that underpins elite athlete performance, as well as seeing firsthand how exercise delivery can help improve the lives of others every day.
<b>Information Technology</b>			
Think Like a Gamer	Mawson Lakes / Your School	60	In this workshop we'll delve into the mind of the gamer. What makes a game playable? How do we engage players in our games?
Robot Battles	Mawson Lakes / Your School	60	Students use Java to develop a robot tank and battle with other teams in an on-screen area. They will learn the basics of programming with RoboCode, and are introduced to artificial intelligence.
Game App Makeover	Mawson Lakes / Your School	60	Customise an existing app for a mobile device to understand the basics of app design, in the Game App makeover. Change colours, fonts and styles and then copy it to your Android to take home.
Inside-Out PC	Mawson Lakes / Your School	60	In the Inside-Out PC workshop, open up the lid of a PC and disconnect the memory, CPU and disk to identify what each part does and to understand how current computers work.
Wifi Safe	Mawson Lakes / Your School	60	Stop hacking or important data being stolen or modified, as you configure a wireless network ensuring all security precautions are taken in the Wifi Safe workshop.
The Tower Challenge	Mawson Lakes / Your School	60	Using a limited supply of materials, students will be challenged to conceptualise and make a tower that meets certain design requirements. Once completed, the towers will be put to the test to see which is the strongest.
Robotics	Mawson Lakes / Your School	60	In this workshop, students will learn about mechatronics and how to control a robot remotely, the role of sensors and how to pick up an object using the data outputted.
Engineers Without Borders	Mawson Lakes / Your School	60	In this workshop students will learn about the important role engineers can play in developing countries, through designing and constructing a water filter and testing solar-powered water pumps.
