Applications for courses starting in 2022

While most courses starting in Semester 1 2022 are now closed to applications, many are still open. Courses starting later in 2022, such as for the midyear intake, are also currently open. Applicants can use SATAC's Course Search to check which courses are still accepting applications.

TAFE SA Semester 2 2022

TAFE SA applications for courses commencing in Semester 2 2022 will open at 9:00am Adelaide time on Tuesday 26 April. Applications are free and submitted online through SATAC.

Applicants to some competitive TAFE SA courses are ranked by the date and time of application, so they should be encouraged to apply as soon as possible after applications open.

Counsellor Information Sessions

SATAC will once again hold information sessions in 2022 for school staff who advise and counsel prospective tertiary applicants. Similar to our 2021 sessions, we anticipate offering these sessions both face-to-face and virtually this year.
