### Counsellor Information Sessions

SATAC will host its 2022 Counsellor Information Sessions both face-to-face and virtually. The sessions will be held in mid-June.

Introductory Counsellor Information Sessions will provide an opportunity for school staff and others new to the SATAC system and processes to gain an understanding of the basics and ask any questions you may have.

We will also hold separate Counsellor Information Sessions primarily aimed at those more experienced in their roles. Attendees will receive a refresher on the SATAC system and processes, as well as catch up on any changes. You will also hear from our participating institutions about a variety of updates.

Places, particularly for face-to-face sessions, will be very limited, so we recommend registering without delay.

### Student Information Sessions

SATAC will hold information sessions in Term 3 for students in Year 12. These sessions will cover the SATAC application process, how the university aggregate and ATAR are calculated, adjustment factor schemes, scaling, and more.

A booking invitation will be sent to schools later this term to register. These sessions were hugely popular last year and availability will be very limited, so please ensure that you book early to avoid disappointment.

## 2022 IB to ATAR combined schedule

For 2022 IB graduates who are applying for admission to tertiary courses commencing in 2023, more detailed information about IB results will be available to tertiary admission centres. This will be used to improve the Combined Rank schedule by providing more conversion points. Scaled total marks from all subjects will be used to differentiate between IB students with the same IB score.
