Applicants should ensure that they have submitted and paid for their SATAC undergraduate application by 1 December to be guaranteed equal consideration. Applications submitted and/or paid for after this date will not be guaranteed equal consideration.

The first offer round in which most current Year 12 applicants will participate in on the basis of their ATARs will be on 11 January. The change of preference deadline for this offer round will be on 3 January.

Offers will continue to be sent on scheduled offer rounds.

International Baccalaureate applicants

Students completing the IB Diploma in South Australia will receive their IB Admissions Score from SATAC. Schools with a Year 12 IB cohort in 2023 have been sent information about how the IBAS will be communicated. School staff with SATAC Schools Web access will also be able to view their students' IBAS on the platform.

Applicants with a 2023 IB Diploma will have an extended change of preference deadline of 3pm on 5 January 2024. IB Coordinators have been emailed instructions to pass on to students regarding the change of preference process.

This extended deadline will only apply to students completing the full IB Diploma in 2023, and not to those who are undertaking standalone IB subjects as part of a local Australian Year 12 qualification.

With the introduction of multifactor authentication to access SATAC Schools Web, a number of users have experienced technical issues with logging into the platform.
